Subject Change of export procedure

Dear customer,

Herewith we want to inform you that due to recent information from the *Controle Orgaan Kwaliteits Zaken* (COKZ, Dutch authority responsible for the export of animal products) there is a change in our export procedure.

From now on Cheesepop food group can only apply for health certificates and veterinary certificates if the goods are picked up from the Cheesepop food group production site and then either

- a) Directly leave the EU by the means of transport (truck)
- b) Are transported from the production location to the airport or harbour and without further storage leave the EU

In any other cases the storage facility needs to be an approved location and has to apply for a health or veterinary certificate on its own.

On request Cheesepop food group can still try to apply for a health or veterinary certificate, but cannot guarantee it – nor can be hold responsible if any problems or damages (also regarding financial loss) occur.
